Written exam and peer review with at least eight years experience including four years of responsible charge beyond the baccalaureate degree. Written exam waived for candidates with more than 16 years experience.

**Board Certified Environmental Engineering Member (BCEEM):** Same requirements as BCEE but P.E. license not required.

**Member:** Minimum of a baccalaureate degree in environmental (or related) engineering and currently practicing in the field or actively engaged in teaching. P.E. license not required.

**Student Member:** Enrolled and pursuing a course of study leading to a degree in environmental engineering or related branch of engineering. Free membership.
